Olde Home Day includes entertainment, vendors & artisans, amusements, demonstrations, and food & drink under the 'big tent'. The event usually attracts 8,000 – 10,000 people from Clinton and surrounding areas. Activities include a free family movie in the park, an art show, puppet shows, Toe Jam Puppet Band, PIAST Polish Dancers, local dance groups, Cody's Martial Arts, Arcade on Wheels, amusements, music, food & drink, & much more.

- Olde Home Day is a rain or shine event.
- Set up time begins at 7:00 AM and ends at 9:00 AM – All vehicles must be off Church, Union, and Walnut Streets by 9:00 a.m. **VEHICLES LEFT ON THESE STREETS WILL BE TOWED AT THEIR OWNER'S EXPENSE after 9:00 AM.**
- Breakdown cannot be done prior to 4:00 PM, unless prior permission is given
- Additional space is available at \$10 per foot.
- Vendors must bring their own canopies/tents (non-staking), tables, chairs, etc.
- Booths are assigned as they are received.
- No electricity is available in the park
- No smoking at your location.
- Absolutely no soliciting outside your booth.
- No staking is allowed in the park due to an underground electrical and sprinkler systems.
- The Olde Day Committee reserves the right to reject an application if deemed not appropriate for the event.
- The Olde Day Committee reserves the right to remove any park vendor/organization that does not abide by these rules & regulations.

- **APPLICATION DEADLINE IS AUGUST 1, 2017 – APPLICATIONS POSTMARKED LATER THAN 8/01/17 WILL BE SUBJECT TO A LATE FEE OF \$25.00 (ParkVendors) (Not applicable to new vendors)**
- Applications received after August 1, 2017 may be excluded from all advertising.

VENDOR INFORMATION

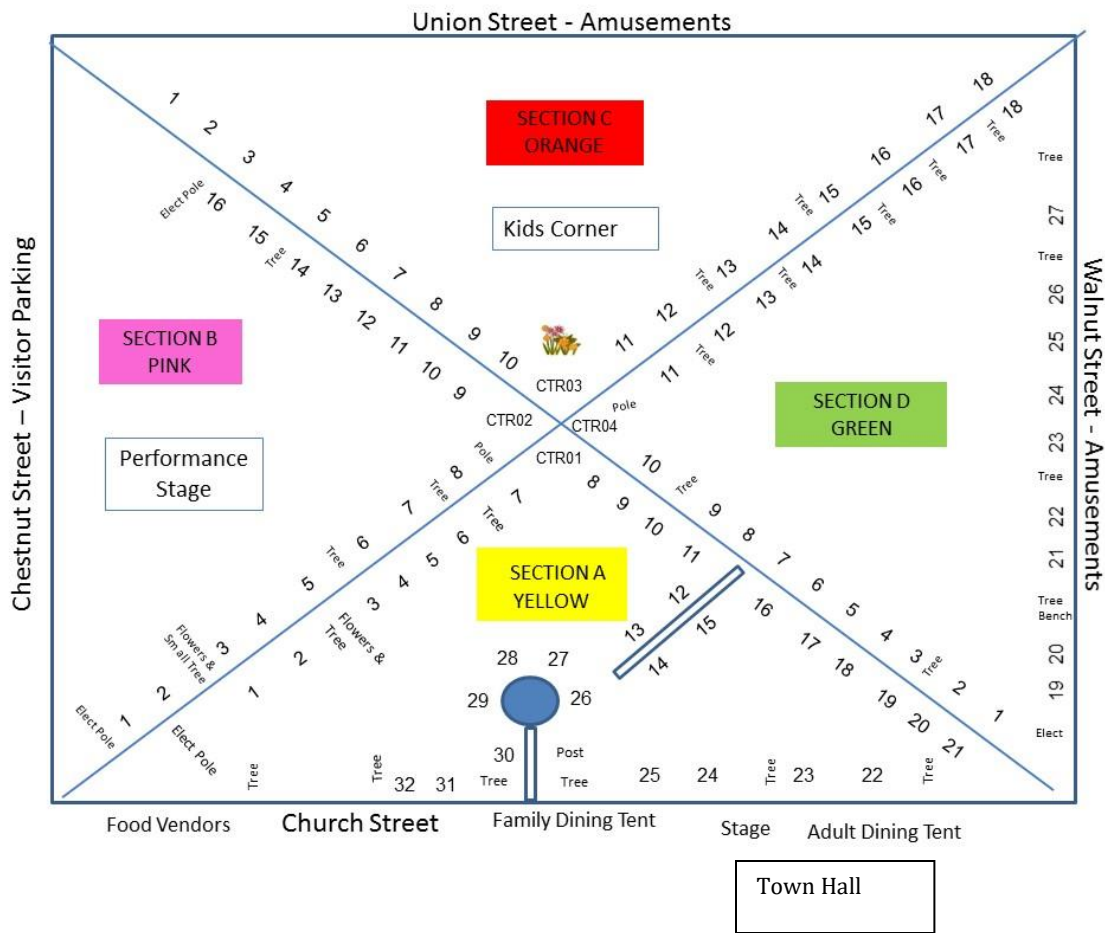
1. Olde Home Day is scheduled to go on, rain or shine. No reimbursements will be made.
2. The committee reserves the right to restrict items sold at the event and will restrict items that jeopardize public safety or create a public nuisance. Examples of such items include: stink bombs, potato guns, hairspray, silly string, etc.
3. With safety in mind, bicycles, skate boards, scooters, roller skates, etc. are prohibited on the streets that are being used for Olde Home Day.
4. Vendors are not allowed to bring pets
5. All vendors will be approved according to their applications. Any additional items to be sold or given out must have committee approval.
6. No solicitation outside your booth area. Violators will be asked to leave the event.

SET-UP AND BREAKDOWN

1. All materials for set-up must be on site no later than 9:00 am.
2. Please leave your area clean. Trash bags will be distributed. Break down all boxes.
3. Unless otherwise cleared by the OHD committee, breakdown begins no earlier than 4pm. Early breakdown sends a negative message to those who attend the event during the latter part of the day and creates a safety hazard for attendees and fellow vendors. If you need to leave prior to 4:00 p.m., we must be notified prior to set up.

SITE PLACEMENT

1. Vendors may make site requests on their application. Whenever possible, requests will be honored.
2. Vendors are placed as they are received. Shade is limited.
3. Applications received after August 1, 2017 will be placed in the park where there is availability.



PARKING

- It is to vendors' benefit that customers can easily reach the event site. Therefore, we would prefer that all participants park at the top of Union Street at St. John's Gym.
- ***Union Street, Walnut Street & Chestnut Street are closed to all traffic & parking***
