Food Vendor Information

- Booth Size: 10'x20' Additional space is available at \$20 per foot.
- RATES: **Non-Profit \$275.00** and **For Profit \$350.00**
- ***Two-day food vendor participation in the Food Court is required.***
- NO REFUNDS AFTER 08/15/2021
- Food Vendors accepted after August 15, 2021 may be excluded from all advertising.
- Staggered Set-Up Times: 12:30 to 1:30 – Food Trucks
1:30 to 2:30 – Tent & Civic Groups

- Clinton's Board of Health inspector is John McNally and can be reached at 978-365-4116. A Food Permit is required and all food vendors are responsible for its fee and completion.
- Each food vendor must speak with BOH regarding their permit. THE FOOD PERMIT IS SEPARATE FROM THE OHD FOOD VENDOR APPLICATION. Both the BOH permit & the OHD Food Vendor application may be downloaded from our website, beginning June 2021.
- We will make every effort to avoid duplication of food/drink selections. Unfortunately, foods/drinks such as "French fries" & "coffee" are at times purchased with other foods/drinks as a complete meal, therefore, our main French Fries vendor (if desired to participate) will continue to sell them separately, but other vendors will have an option to sell French Fries as part of a meal and those vendors will NOT BE ALLOWED to sell fries as a separate food selection.
- A Serve/Safe Food Inspector (from Clinton's BOH) will be onsite Friday & Saturday prior to the start of the event to assure proper safety, heating and cleanliness requirements are met.
- ***Each Food Vendor is required to provide the committee with five (5) \$5.00 food vouchers that will be used at the discretion of the committee.***
- Food Vendors are placed in our Food Court on Church Street – entrance is from Chestnut Street.
- Olde Home Days is a rain or shine event. No refunds / reimbursements will be made.
- ***Breakdown should not begin prior to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, unless prior approval from coordinator.***
- No sales other than food are allowed in the food court.
- Vendors are responsible for their own canopies, tents, tables, chairs, etc.
- ***OHDs IS A NON-SMOKING EVENT. SMOKING LOCATIONS ARE OFF-SITE & AWAY FROM ALL ACTIVITIES.***
- Absolutely no soliciting outside your booth.
- The Olde Home Days Committee reserves the right to reject an application if deemed not appropriate for the event and also reserves the right to remove any vendor/organization that does not abide by these & regulations.
- Vendors are not allowed to bring pets, unless medically needed & necessary paperwork must be onsite.
- All vendors will be approved according to their applications. Any additional items to be sold or given out must have committee approval.
- Please leave your area clean. Trash bags will be distributed. Break down all boxes. A dumpster will be located at the top of Church Street. No dumping of "grease" or other liquids, other than water into storm drains is allowed.
